Fund Name Will Change, New Fund to Launch

Effective on or around April 1, 2016, American Funds will change the name of its money market fund and introduce a new flexible-core bond fund.

Please make the necessary changes in your recordkeeping system.



American Funds Money Market Fund®

Effective on or around April 1, 2016, American Funds Money Market Fund will be renamed American Funds U.S. Government Money Market FundSM.

In addition to the name change, the fund will increase its investment in qualifying government securities to meet the standards of a government money market fund. The impact to the fund's investment strategy should be minimal, since the current money market fund already invests primarily in U.S. government securities.

The changes to the money market fund are in response to amendments adopted in July 2014 by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). These amendments impose new requirements on money market mutual funds.
